At the gates in Nurmo and Kauhajoki, the registers are maintained by a subcontractor, the security firm Securitas Oy (Business ID 1773518-5). The agreement between Atria and Securitas contains a confidentiality clause, and the personal data in the registers will only be available to Atria Finland Ltd.

What personal data do we collect?

We collect the following data from all visitors to Atria Finland Ltd's plants: name, company name, and health data relevant to product safety.

In addition to the above, we collect the following data from partners visiting the plants: work address, telephone numbers, and email address. If applicable, tax numbers as well as data on licence cards and certificates of qualification are also collected. Furthermore, partners working with devices that are in contact with products are entered in a salmonella certificate register with the person's name, company, date of birth, and date of the salmonella certificate.

We also collect event-related data from persons participating in events or training sessions organised by Atria Finland.

The personal data is generally collected from the individuals themselves or their employers.

What do we use personal data for?

Personal health data is used to prevent the spread of diseases relevant to product safety (generally dangerous and controlled infectious diseases as well as animal diseases to be combated).

The personal data of partners is used:

- To maintain, manage and develop the partnership
- To process and deliver orders
- To organise events and training sessions
- For communications

The personal data will not be used in automated decision-making or profiling.

For partners, the data is processed based on the partnership between the partner and Atria Finland Ltd.

How do we process, store and protect personal data?

Access to personal data is limited to those who need the data to manage their duties. The data can also be processed by our system suppliers in connection with system testing or development.

The data can be transferred to our trusted contractual partners on a case-by-case basis. Requirements of the EU General Data Protection Regulation and other legislation have been taken into consideration with all our contractual partners.

All personal data is protected in accordance with Atria Finland Ltd's data protection policy against unauthorised access and unintentional or unlawful data processing. Data at the gate is collected by Securitas Oy, but the data is intended for use by Atria.

In processing personal data and planning processing, we comply with the EU General Data Protection Regulation, in force as of 25 May 2018. Access to personal data is controlled in accordance with good practices.

The data will under no circumstances be transferred outside the EU/EEA.

How long do we store personal data?

Regarding the health survey, we store the visitors' personal data six months. The salmonella certificate data is stored at least two years.

For partners, we store the personal data for the period required by the relationship between the partner and Atria Finland Ltd, so that we can fulfil the purposes described in this privacy statement.

Rights of the data subject

You have the right to:

- Gain access to your personal data and obtain a copy of your personal data
- Request rectification and erasure of your personal data
- Under certain conditions, request restriction of processing or object to processing of personal data
- In certain cases, request transfer of your personal data to another system
