

Processing of personal data pertaining to registration for the 2022 Annual General Meeting of Atria Plc

In this privacy notice, we inform you about the processing of your personal data that we collect when you register for the 2022 Annual General Meeting of Atria Plc.

Controller and contact information

As a controller for the processing of personal data shall act:

Why are we processing personal data?

We process personal data in order to enter AGM registrations in the system, in order for us to verify the person's identity and his/her right to participate in the Annual General Meeting on 3 May 2022. The information is also used for printing the list of participants and voting list for the Annual General Meeting and for taking care of possible voting. A list of participants will be annexed to the minutes of the Annual General Meeting.

Atria Plc processes personal data in order to comply with its legal obligations, under Companies Act and Securities Market Act.

Personal data shall not be used for automatic decision making or profiling.

What types of and whose personal data does Atria Plc process?

We only process personal data that is required for the purposes described above. Among these are contact information, such as the name, the address, the phone number, the e-mail address, the personal identity code or date-of-birth/business identity code, the number of the book-entry account, the number of shares and votes owned. We process personal data relating to a shareholder, his/her representative, proxy representative, and to the possible assistant of the aforementioned.

When a shareholder registers online, a person uses strong electronic identification with Finnish online banking credentials or mobile certificate to enter the registration system. Euroclear Finland Ltd will act as the technical facilitator of the data collection and a person submits the necessary information about himself/herself. When a shareholder registers by any other way than online, Atria Plc / Euroclear Finland Ltd collects the information required for registration from the shareholder and submits the data in the system maintained by Euroclear Finland Ltd. Using the entered personal identification code as a reference, the system compares the entered information with the shareholders' register of the company maintained by Euroclear Finland Ltd and collects the person's share ownership information from the shareholders' register. The book-entry account number is used exclusively for the identification in Euroclear Finland Ltd's system and will not be disclosed to the data controller. To verify the correctness of voting results, the data controller has access to an individual shareholder's voting information.

How do we process, protect and maintain your personal data?

The personal data is processed in Euroclear Finland Ltd's electronic Annual General Meeting service. Euroclear Finland Ltd shall be responsible for the maintenance of the register. The telecommunications connection from the user's browser to the server is encrypted with SSL. The online registration site uses technical data protection aiming at keeping the entered information intact and available only to those who are entitled to access the information. Technical data protection consists of encrypting telecommunications, monitoring message integrity and identifying the user, among other things.

Your personal data is accessible only those employees who must process the personal data in order to carry out their duties.

Your personal data is not assigned or transferred by Atria Oyj outside EU or European Economic Area.

How long we store your personal data?

Your personal data is stored only as long as it is necessary for the purposes described in this privacy note or according to the legislation. Euroclear Finland Ltd retains personal data stored in the registration system for four months from the end of the Annual General Meeting. A list of participants will be annexed to the minutes of the Annual General Meeting. The list includes the name of the shareholder, number of the ballot and details on ownership (number of shares and votes). The minutes and its annexes will be stored throughout the operational life of the data controller in order to comply with the data controller's statutory obligations.

Rights of the Data Subject

You have right:

- Right of access to your data. You have a right to be informed whether we process your personal data, and if we do, to receive a copy of your personal data and additional information about processing of personal data carried out by Atria.
- Right to correction of your data. You have a right to have your incorrect personal data corrected and/or updated.
